### Making the move into a senior care facility

A once a year check-in at holiday times may uncover that over the course of a year, Mom or Dad have become neglectful of their health, scarily more forgetful or just too ill to care for themselves. Debbie Baker, director of community relations at The Weatherly Inn, said, "Most people move into our community because they are no longer able to live safely in their home" due to key factors such as previous falls, rehabilitation stays, loss of a spouse, isolation or medication management." Moving within a tight time frame as a response to emergency needs can be daunting

"There are a few different things that people can do to research long-term care settings before choosing a place for themselves or a family member," according to Nellis Kim, Regional Long-Term Care Ombudsman for Pierce County. "Once a person has an idea of what criteria are most important (e.g., proximity to family, proximity to doctors, level of care), he or she can generate a list of licensed long-term care settings by visiting www. aasa.dshs.wa.gov to search for adult family homes by zip code or county, or to look for licensed boarding homes (including assisted living residences)." One very useful tool Kim recommends is that DSHS has begun posting enforcement letters issued to facilities with deficiencies. Family members can read the letters sent to the residential care provider. She encourages families to request to see the most recent inspection report whenever they

visit adult family homes or boarding homes. However, although DSHS also has a site for nursing homes, it does not reflect citations or enforcement actions in the same way that the AFH and BH sites do.

Kim recommends that families visit Medicare. gov. "The Medicare website allows visitors to search for nursing homes by name, zip code, city, state, or county. A few years ago, Medicare introduced their five-star rating system, so when the list of nursing homes appears on the screen, there are star ratings given in different categories. I always encourage families to look beyond the stars and actually click through to the health inspection, staffing, and quality measure content." Surveys are not yet posted on the Medicare website so when families visit the facilities they should ask to see the survey there. Kim adds that, "these can be lengthy documents, but they are very telling when it comes to describing specific areas of practice where the facility failed to meet established standards."

Long-Term Care Ombudsman can share information about verified complaints involving specific facilities that they have investigated within the past year. Ombudsmen may also be able to provide general information about facilities. For example said Kim, "If a family wants to know how many times the Director of Nursing Services has changed at a particular facility in the past year, we may be able to provide that information, especially

if we have a staff or volunteer ombudsman assigned there on a regular basis." She strongly recommends that families visit the residence. "I tell families that if they are able, visit multiple times and go at different times of the day. If you are looking at a nursing home or boarding home, try visiting at "off" hours and see whether you hear people calling out for help with no response, see if staff are taking personal calls on their cell phones, or if they are attending to residents, see if residents who need supervision appear to wandering the halls without anyone's knowledge. Try visiting at a change of shift, or visiting at mealtimes to see what is being served. If you or a loved one enjoys a specific activity offered by the facility, drop by when that activity appears on the calendar; is it really being offered? Is there a staff person there to facilitate the activity?" Visits also give families a chance to see the other residents, meet staff, observe interactions between staff and residents, and ask questions of the providers.

Kim recommends checking with the facility for referrals from former residents and family members of former residents. Ask referral sources if they recommend the facility to others and what they saw as the negatives and positives. "Many families go strictly by word of mouth without considering that their loved one has really different needs from their friend's family member.
