
ABOUT LUTHERAN COMMUNITY SERVICES NORTHWEST

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

You may qualify for a 30% discount on your utility bill if you meet all these criteria:


- ☐ You are 62 or older **OR** a disabled adult receiving qualifying disability income

- ☐ Your monthly household income is not more than:
